**Internship Responsibilities:** Intern will work with a team of staff and volunteers to implement this program at the highest level. Responsibilities will include helping plan and facilitate daily day camp activities that provide enrichment and prosocial opportunities for children who face suburban poverty. Part of the planned activities will revolve around a child-run restaurant, depending on the site. This is an opportunity to develop leadership, organization, and people skills. Interns are also strongly encouraged to bring their unique skills/gifts and passions to this program. Examples: an intern passionate about photography could serve as site photographer; art education major could plan and execute art projects with the children; recreation management major could offer skills clinics and organize a friendly tournament on site. **What is your passion/area of study? **Internship Commitment:** Anticipated dates for summer 2017 are June 5 through August 4, with varying hours between 9am and 4pm. Volunteer hours will be flexible and vary based on internship objectives. **4 week minimum is required. You choose the weeks.** Perfect for college students returning to school as early as mid to late summer.

**Compensation:** This is an unpaid *opportunity to gain valuable work experience in your chosen field while developing leadership, organization and people skills.* Intern will track and receive a signed copy of internship hours for employment and/or graduate school applications. Upon successful completion of the internship, intern will also receive an individualized letter of recommendation.

- Be a role model at all times to the younger children: consistently demonstrating patience, kindness, encouragement and enthusiasm.
