

Hilliard Free Lunch Summer Camp for Kids 2017 Teen Internship - ages 15-18

Now in its 11th year the Hilliard Free Lunch Summer Camp for Kids welcomes low income children from culturally diverse backgrounds to join us daily for friendship, recreation, special activities and a nutritious, free lunch. Last summer we served children at 4 camp sites in Hilliard.

We are seeking Teen Interns to act as positive role models while playing with and building relationships with the children we serve. In addition, Teen Interns will support the staff with camp operations including camp set up, clean up and running camp activities.

Commitment: Intern must commit to a minimum of **FOUR weeks (Monday-Friday) of their choice between June 14th – July 28, 2017**. The hours vary from site to site but fall between the hours of 9:00 am-3:30 pm. In addition, we ask Interns to write one blog per week about their experience (guidelines provided). Interns are encouraged to identify program areas (such as recreation, music, art, academic enrichment, skits) of particular interest to them to apply *their* passions and skill sets for the enrichment of the children. This will be discussed further upon meeting. Training for new Teen Interns is tentatively scheduled for the week of June 5; specific dates and times to be determined.

Recommendation Letter: This is an unpaid Teen Internship position. However, *this is an amazing opportunity working with children while developing leadership, organization and people skills*. Intern will track and receive a signed copy of internship hours for National Honor Society, service clubs and college or employment applications. Upon successful completion of the internship, teen will also receive an individualized letter of recommendation.

Skills/Qualities Needed:

- Enjoy working with elementary age children in a fun, high-energy, multicultural environment.
- Always do one's best & work hard to make this program the best it can be.
- Dedication to learning and following rules and procedures.
- Be a role model always to the younger children: consistently demonstrating patience, kindness, encouragement and enthusiasm.
- Reliable with a track record of keeping commitments and following through
- Bi-Lingual a plus, Spanish and/or Arabic helpful but not required.
