Volunteer Opportunities

For: Adults/Groups*, Teens^ and Families+

Ongoing Year-Round Opportunities

- ***Office Support** – Help with administrative duties during regular business hours.
- ***Translation/Interpreting Services** – as needed – particularly in Spanish, Somali or Arabic.
- ***+Community Garden Assistant** – Help plant, harvest and deliver fresh produce to families facing poverty.
- ***+Donate Items** – Books, nonperishable food, gift cards, etc. See website for list.
- ***Legal Clinic** – Attorneys can volunteer through Legal Aid; volunteers are also needed to staff the legal clinic.
- ***Job Jump Start** – Job readiness clinic providing help with interviewing skills, job applications, resume review, networking and more.
- ***Entrepreneurial Opportunity** – Support the children with running their own business during programming. Examples could include supporting operations, overseeing food preparation, planning “shopping” trips for required items, etc. See our website for seasonal details.

Full Family ESL Program Opportunities (October-April)

- ***+Snack Angels**– Provide a light meal once or monthly for the hungry children who attend our Family ESL Program.
- ***+Academic Support** – Help school aged children (K-8) with homework, on educational websites, math and reading.
- ***+Indoor Recess** – Play with children (K-8) in an indoor gym recess environment with Legos, board games and crafts.
- ***+Early Childhood**– Help children (3 months-pre k) prepare for kindergarten with love, language and literacy.
- ***Assist English as a Second Language (ESL)** – Help alongside teacher with adults as they learn English.
- ***Hospitality**– Set up refreshment for adult students during their breaktime.

SON Ministries Summer Lunch Camp Opportunities (June-July)

- ***Lunchtime Opportunity** – Serve children a healthy prepared lunch and visit with them 1 full week or 1 set day per week over the summer, 1½ hours per day.
- ***+Small Group Opportunity** – Form a group (3-10 people) of adults or youth plus chaperones to experience the joy of serving children facing suburban poverty in our community. Learn how to build cross-national/ socioeconomic relationships. Assist staff serving lunch and playing games with children.
- ***+Adult Camp Volunteer** – Spend 2-3 hours playing with children at camp and over lunch. Fun and rewarding experience with lasting impact for you and your children. To build relationships with staff and children, commit to a full week or a fixed day.
